9. ***Kindergarten students must be five years of age and first graders six years of age on or before August 31, the year they begin that grade.***
10. ***Pre-school students must be at least three years of age and potty trained in order to enroll in the three year-old program.***
11. ***Students applying to attend after first semester for grades 1-8 must receive Board of Directors approval.***
